CHECK



Check for leaks. Indoors, look for dripping faucets, showerheads, sprinklers, and listen for running toilets. Outdoors, check irrigation systems and spigots or hose bibbs.

TWIST



Twist and tighten faucet, showerhead, hose, and pipe connections to stop drips. To save more water, twist a WaterSense labeled aerator on to your bathroom faucet.

REPLACE



Replace old or broken fixtures with WaterSense labeled models, which are independently certified to use 20 percent less water and perform as well or better than standard models.

DOES YOUR TOILET HAVE A **SILENT LEAK?**

Drop a dye tablet or add a few drops of food coloring into your toilet's tank and wait 10 minutes.

If the color shows up in the bowl, you have a leak that can probably be fixed by replacing a worn toilet flapper.

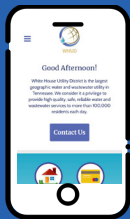

Don't forget to flush afterwards to remove any dye.
